Fisher Tank Company To Open State-Of-The-Art Facility

Batesburg-Leesville, South Carolina – May 12, 2010 – Fisher Tank Company plans to begin operations at its new facility in Batesburg-Leesville, South Carolina, in June 2010.

The new 85,000 ft² fabrication facility will feature state of the art equipment including plasma arc cutting tables, an environmentally controlled paint room, an automated overhead crane and track system and Wheelabrator automated shot blast machine. The expanded fitting shop will include Gorbelt work station cranes and a central weld fume collection exhaust system.

Expanded operations will include increased fabrication capacity, shop blasting and painting, and custom fabrication capabilities.

In addition to the fabrication facilities, the new property will include a 13,000 ft² office for administrative, sales, project management and safety personnel and a 6,250 ft² maintenance shop.

Future plans include construction of a rail siding with increased outside material handling capability.

Fisher Tank Company provides engineering and design services, custom fabrication, tank construction, turn key construction services, shop and field painting and repair and maintenance services for field erected welded steel tanks and other vessels.
